

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT 5th & 6th GRADE DAY

1. How can I register a 5th or 6th Grade student?

Simply visit www.ursuline.com/RSVP and locate the Ursuline High School 5th & 6th Grade Day Registration link. Be sure to print, sign, and send the permission slip with your child on March 31, 2023.

2. When will students get their schedules?

Students will get their schedules when they arrive at Ursuline for the event on March 31.

3. What will the students do during the day?

All the 5th & 6th graders will participate in three different sessions of their choice, watch a performance in the Auditorium, join us for lunch, and attend an exciting closing assembly.

4. Where should the students get dropped off?

Please drop the students off at the entrance in the back of the school building, off Bryson Street. Use the Westbound Service Road, adjacent to the expressway, and turn right onto Bryson Street. The school will be on the right. The main door is the one with the wheelchair ramp. We will have Ursuline Student Ambassadors at the door to greet our guests.

5. What time does it start and end?

Please arrive by 8:45 a.m. on March 31, 2023. For parents providing their own transportation, dismissal is at 2:00 pm. Please park in the Bryson Street lot and enter the building to meet the children in the Alumni & Development Office, Room 121. Please let us know if your son/daughter will be picked up by someone other than a parent/guardian. If other arrangements need to be made, simply call the school at 330-744-4563.

6. Can my son or daughter go home with a sibling who is an Ursuline student?

Sure! Have the 5th or 6th grader meet his or her older sibling in the gymnasium at the end of the day.

7. What should the students wear?

Feel free to dress down for the day. Please no hats, ripped jeans, or shorts. Athletic shoes would be best for sports sessions.

8. What's for lunch?

A free lunch, courtesy of the Ursuline Ambassadors, includes pizza, fries, a DQ Dilly Bar, fruit, and milk. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch if preferred.
