

Dear AP Calculus Students,

For this Summer's assignments you will be receiving by email worksheets designed to help you to the next level. First, understand that the purpose is to help you. These worksheets will not affect your grades. I will be keeping track of what you do and you will have an opportunity to get help with anything that troubles you. You are beginning the home stretch towards the actual AP test next Spring.

You will receive the worksheets on 6/12, 6/26, 7/10, 7/24, and 8/7. They will be fairly long and involved. You will be practicing skills that you have already acquired and *writing* about Mathematics using mathematical terms correctly to explain ideas. This is necessary for success on the AP. There should not be anything new. Perhaps, there will be new ways of looking at, using, and explaining ideas and techniques that you have acquired over the last 11 years of schooling. You will email to me copies of your work on the Wednesday before the next assignment is made. There will be answer keys made available on the Thursday before the next assignment is made. Also, on the morning on which the next assignment is made I will be available on ZOOM for which you will all receive an invitation. At which time, we can discuss your work and how it can be improved. You may also ask questions on things that are not clear. **No one is required to attend any sessions.** They are available for your use.

To be clear, as an example - I will email you the first assignment on 6/12. You are to email me a copy of your work by 6/24. I will email an answer key on 6/25. On 6/26, there will be a ZOOM session available and you will get the next worksheet. The rest of the Summer should proceed along the same lines.
